A completed & signed form is required for every student riding a FPS bus for the 2016-17 school year.

All requests for transportation will be cross referenced with FPS district policies regarding eligibility to ride the bus. The decision of FPS Transportation Department is final. Those eligible will receive a letter in August with the bus stop location and time.

Mercy High School transportation will be provided on the Farmington Public Schools High schools transportation schedule.

Transportation is only set up for 1 school year and will need to be re-set up every school year in August.

Mercy Students eligible for AM transportation will ride on a High School bus route or walk to their home public High School for transportation. They will then transfer onto a shuttle bus that will take them to Harrison HS where they will transfer onto another shuttle bus that will take them to Mercy HS. Arrival time to Mercy is approximately 7:56 am, weather and traffic permitting.

Mercy Students eligible for PM transportation will be dropped off in the P.M. at either their Home High School or their home public High School bus stop as determined by the transportation department. Students are only allowed to travel to and from school from their designated stop only. A Farmington Public School bus will arrive at Mercy High School at between 2:40-2:50 pm and leave promptly at 2:50pm.

If your Mercy Student does not ride the bus for 10 consecutive days your bus stop will be removed and you will have to call transportation to have reinstated. Your child will NOT be allowed to ride the bus until reinstated.

Mercy High School must follow the Farmington Public Schools yearly calendar in order to receive transportation services. If Mercy High School chooses not to follow FPS calendar Mercy Parents must provide their own transportation.

Riding the bus is a PRIVILEGE, not a Right. Students who misbehave on the school bus will be denied the right to ride the bus for a specified period of time, usually ranging from one to ten days. Repeated misconduct or conduct detrimental to the safety of other students may be grounds for permanent suspension of bus privileges.

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a well-behaved manner while riding the school bus. FPS reserves the right to remove any student whose behavior is detrimental to the safety of other students riding the bus. Parents who have concerns about behavior or the safety of students riding the bus should contact the school principal immediately.

Parents will be contacted regarding students who are reported for misconduct on the bus. Students who misbehave on the bus will be subject to disciplinary action which may include suspension from the bus for a specified period of time or in serious cases permanent removal from the bus.

Please sign one copy of this Agreement indicating that you will support the terms outlined above and return to Mercy High School so transportation can be schedule if needed for the 2016-17 school years.
