The Mercy Performing Arts Camp is designed to make your child feel like a Broadway star!

Students will be immersed into the world of musical theatre as they sing, dance, and perform the day away. All skill levels welcome!

Emphasis will be given to proper vocal technique, stage presence, acting technique, and musical theatre style choreography. This is a great opportunity for young performers to work with Performing Arts professionals. Open to all students entering grades 6 - 9 in the fall of 2026, this camp will promote confidence, social skills, and collaboration.

Camp will culminate in a **one night only** performance of *Disney's Dare to Dream Jr.* a musical celebrating 100 years of Disney movies, performed in Mercy High School's auditorium.

What to Wear

Wear comfortable clothing, suitable for dancing and movement. Shoes should be closed toed. Keep in mind that some spaces at Mercy High School are not air conditioned.

What to Bring

Campers must bring a refillable water bottle, lunch, and snack.

Performance Costume

Once casting is done, parents/campers will be asked to supply base costume items, dependent on their role. A list will be provided by the end of the first week of camp.
