

September 29th - October 9th 10 DAYS TO SELL!

Mercy staff and families will be selling tickets during the annual <u>Maroon & Gold Raffle</u> to benefit the General Fund, which supports the tuition gap, curriculum enhancements, facility upgrades and technology updates.

Every family is expected to sell at least 35 tickets per student at \$5 per ticket (30 tickets per student for families with multiple students), per your enrollment agreement. Keep in mind this is only the minimum, and we encourage everyone to sell more in support of meeting our \$150,000 goal! Additional tickets will be available in the Reception Area.

TICKETS

Turning in your money and tickets:

- Each raffle ticket MUST be filled out completely, not just the top ticket, and YOUR NAME needs to be on the "Student Name" portion of the ticket.
- Please keep all books STAPLED when you submit them.
- Ticket stubs (the small part) can only be returned with matching funds, either cash or check.
 - Double check your tickets and money match they will be sent back to you if they do not match.
 - Full payment must accompany each raffle ticket in order to count for awards and our total goal. Please turn in all collection envelopes to your Adviser.
 - Checks can be made out to Mercy High School.
- Use the envelope provided, with your name and Advisor name, to submit your ticket stubs and money.
- Please return any unsold tickets to your Advisor or the Reception Area. If you need more tickets, they are also available at the Reception Area.

OUT OF UNIFORM

- Out of Uniform: Eligibility: 40 tickets/35 tickets for each sister and staff
 - Hot pink wristband from your Advisor Wristband must be visible at all times for the student to be out of uniform.
 - Out of Uniform

 - 11/27 through the end of December
 - 4/8 through the end of the year
- Shorts: Eligibility: 60 tickets/55 tickets for each sister and staff
 - Pink Tag from your Advisor must be visible at all times.
- Leggings: Eligibility: 80 tickets/75 tickets for each sister and staff
 - Green Tag from your Advisor must be visible at all times.
- NEW Mercy Sweatshirt: Eligibility: 100 tickets/95 tickets for each sister and staff
 - Orange Tag from your Advisor must be visible at all times.
 - Wear your favorite Mercy sweatshirt for the rest of the year on Fridays!

Guidelines:

- Guidelines:
- Students may wear jeans, pajama pants or sweatpants in addition to Special Dress Day attire.
- Students may wear non-uniform shoes, including Birkenstock clogs, Crocs and UGG slippers
- It is inappropriate to expose hips, midriffs or cleavage, which means no crop tops.
- Ripped clothing, shorts (of any kind without a pass), spaghetti straps, camis and strapless tops are not allowed.
- Leggings must be worn with a top that covers your bottom. If it does not, you will lose your Leggings Pass and will
 not be able to earn it back.

- Shorts must be fingertip length or longer.
- The wristband and other out of uniform tags are your uniform pass and must be visible at all times. Failure to have the required wristband or tags while out of uniform could result in a detention.

 - o Winner is based on a normalized number due to the different sizes in each grade.
