All school operating expenses are paid for through student tuition and the generous support of donors.

There are several ways in which to sponsor a Mercy girl. The following opportunities would cover the Tuition and Fees for the 2019-2020 School Year.

FULL TUITION: \$13,720 (with fees \$14,070) **HALF TUITION: \$6,860** (with fees \$7,210)

Your donation may be made in one lump sum or spread out in monthly payments. Please note that sponsored students will be chosen through our internal Tuition Assistance process based on several specific criteria. All final decisions are made at the discretion of the Mercy Administration.

TUITION ASSISTANCE FUND

If you are unable to sponsor a student at any of these levels, please consider a donation to our Tuition Assistance Fund. All donations to this fund are used to give financial aid packages to a large number of young women who would not otherwise be able to attend Mercy High School. Donations given prior to July 1 will support the following school year.
