

We were honored to welcome Lisa Damour, Ph.D. renowned psychologist, NYT bestselling author, adolescent development expert, and *Inside Out 2* consultant, for an inspiring series of discussions on resilience, emotional well-being, and personal growth.

Through engaging presentations for over 400 parents and over 1,500 students, Dr. Damour provided practical strategies for overcoming challenges, building healthy relationships, and balancing social media while staying true to oneself. With a warm and relatable approach, she empowered our young women to navigate life with strength, purpose, and faith.



Merci, Madame!

Celebrating 50 Years of Joyce Smetanka Campbell at Mercy



For **50 remarkable years**, **Madame Joyce Campbell** has inspired generations of Mercy students to fall in love with the French language and culture. As Chair of the World Languages Department, she leads a vibrant team of educators offering French, Spanish, and Latin at every level, including Advanced Placement. She moderates the French Honor Society and French Club, fostering a community that celebrates the beauty, diversity, and global influence of the Francophone world.

“French has always been more than a subject — it is a doorway to art, cuisine, history, travel, and human connection,” she reflects. “The language brings people together across geography and time, and it allows me to open the world to my students in ways that feel both beautiful and meaningful.”

Throughout her career, Madame Campbell has championed innovation and excellence. She helped establish two language labs at Mercy and continues to weave technology and creativity into her instruction. Her classroom is a place where *la langue française* comes alive through lessons on theater, art, poetry, and architecture; immersive cultural experiences; and decades of memories from 24 student trips to France with 525 participants. She has also led students to the Detroit Institute of Arts, the Fisher Theatre, the Detroit Opera House, and local French restaurants, along with Mercy’s annual National French Week celebrations sponsored by the AATF.

“In the 1990s and early 2000s, the Drama Studio became something magical each December when it transformed into Le Café-Club Paradis,” she recalls. “With the help of my family, friends, and enthusiastic students, we created a little corner of Paris right inside Mercy — a boulangerie, a pâtisserie, a fruit market, even a boucherie.”

Today, National French Week remains a beloved tradition featuring morning prayers and trivia, a t-shirt contest, art and music, crêpes, and a special dinner at Cuisine Detroit. A highlight this year was a macaron-making demonstration by alumna Tina Aiello Sturgis '90, who studied French pastry in Paris.


Madame Campbell’s influence extends well beyond the classroom. Many of her former students now serve in diplomacy, law, business, education, and other fields, carrying with them the cultural awareness and leadership foundations she helped build. Among her most cherished memories is reconnecting in Paris with alumna Meghan Ronayne Dubois '11, who was living and working there through a special company program. Meghan was the first to request France as her assignment from her strong French skills and cultural confidence rooted in her years at Mercy.



"When we met in Paris, it was a full-circle moment," Madame Campbell shares.

"To walk the city with a former student — now a poised professional speaking fluent French — was one of the greatest joys of my career."

In addition to her work with students, Madame Campbell has shared her expertise with language educators nationwide. She has presented at local, state, regional, and national conferences — including Oakland Schools, the Michigan World Language Association, the Central States Conference, and the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages — offering workshops on how Project-Based Learning enhances target-language proficiency.



Her professional achievements are both extensive and deeply earned. Madame Campbell was recently recognized as **one of just eight Outstanding French Honor Society Moderators nationwide by the American Association of Teachers of French (AATF)**. She has also been invited to present at the Central States Foreign Language Teachers Conference, sharing innovative approaches to using AI in project-based French learning. Past honors include being named Mercy's Teacher of the Year (2009), Michigan World Language Association Teacher of the Year (1995), recipient of the Intercultural Student Experiences Language Matters Award (2008), and the MIWLA Barbara Ort-Smith Award (2018). Her affiliations span the AATF, the French Institute Alliance Française of Michigan, the Oakland Schools World Language Leaders Advisory Council, and the Central States Conference.

"Some of my favorite moments as a teacher happen when I watch students discover something new," she says. "The first time they hold a real conversation, taste a warm crêpe, interpret an Impressionist painting, recognize a lyric in a French song, or stand in awe beneath the Eiffel Tower. Their joy fuels my own passion."

Investing in the Future of French at Mercy

A new scholarship has been established to support Mercy students committed to studying French. This scholarship reflects the deep care of lead donor **Rosemary Ebner Pomeroy '73** and her fellow contributors who studied French in the 1970s under Patricia Small, Mrs. Riffle and Sister Joel. While the size of the French program has decreased over time, its impact remains strong, and this scholarship aims to ensure that future generations of students can continue to experience the richness of French language and culture.

MERCY GOES GLOBAL: LANGUAGE, LEARNING, ADVENTURE & SERVICE

From Rome to Paris to the Rio Grande Valley, Mercy students spent their spring and summer breaks learning, serving, and exploring the world beyond the classroom. Whether through language immersion or faith-centered service, each journey reflected Mercy's spirit and mission.

Exploring the Roman World: Latin Students Abroad

Over Easter 2025, Mercy Latin students joined Brother Rice students on an unforgettable 12-day journey through Italy, France, and Belgium. From exploring the Vatican Museums and Colosseum to studying masterpieces at the Louvre and Royal Museum of Fine Arts, students deepened their understanding of classical history and the enduring influence of Latin. Highlights included creating frescoes in Florence, biking through Rome, and offering prayer in the newly reopened Notre-Dame Cathedral.



Le Grand Voyage: French Students in France

Over the summer, 3rd and 4th-year French students, led by Madame Joyce Campbell, embarked on *Le Grand Voyage*: a cultural and linguistic adventure through Normandy, the Loire Valley, Paris, and Provence. Students visited D-Day beaches, royal châteaux, and Versailles, practiced their French at local markets, and even learned to make macarons with a Parisian baker. In Provence and Nice, they painted like Cézanne, swam in the Mediterranean, and explored French artistry through a perfume-making workshop.



Spanish Students in Spain & Morocco

In June, Mercy Spanish students, accompanied by Mrs. Julia Cilona, traveled through Granada, Seville, and the Costa del Sol, immersing themselves in Spain's vibrant culture and language. Their adventure concluded with a day trip to Tangier, Morocco, where they rode camels, sampled Moroccan cuisine, and explored bustling markets. It was an unforgettable cross-cultural experience linking continents and communities.



Serving with Compassion: Summer Immersion Trips

Two groups of Mercy students also spent their summer break living out the Gospel through service and solidarity.

In Texas, students and staff Holly Markiecki-Bennetts and Dr. Alison Kline-Kator '97 partnered with **Arise Adelante**, an organization founded by Sister of Mercy Gerrie Naughton to empower women and children in the Rio Grande Valley. Working alongside Mercy schools from across the country, they built relationships, led youth activities, and deepened their understanding of the Mercy mission.

Mercy staff Curt Klueg and Brenda Bagazinski, along with six students, spent a powerful week at **Nazareth Farm in West Virginia**, serving others and living out the Gospel through community, simplicity, prayer, and service. Alongside other volunteers, they helped repair homes for local residents, embraced Appalachian culture, and encountered God through the meaningful relationships formed throughout the week.


Saturday, November 22, was a truly historic day to be a Marlin as Mercy captured two MHSAA State Championships. Mercy earned the Division 2 Swim & Dive title and the Division 1 Volleyball title.

VOLLEYBALL: BACK ON TOP OF THE STATE

Mercy Volleyball powered its way to the top with a 25–18, 25–20, 23–25, 25–20 victory over Bloomfield Hills. This championship is the team's second state title in three years and reflects Mercy's ongoing strength and consistency in Michigan high school volleyball.

SWIM & DIVE: THREE-PEAT GLORY

Across the state, the excitement continued as Mercy Swim & Dive secured its third consecutive Division 2 State Championship and the program's 14th overall. The Marlins hit the wall first in a thrilling relay finish. Avery Tack '27, Campbell Shore '27, Lyla Collins '29, and Ella Hafner '28 touched in 3:26.05 to officially clinch the title.



Avery Tack '27 broke the CHSL 100 Yard Breaststroke record with a time of 1:04.76 during CHSL Championship Prelims.

Ella Hafner '28 broke the MHSAA D2 Record for the 500 Yard Freestyle with a time of 4:49.74.





2025 GARN GRIFFIN AWARDS

The Garn Griffin Athletic Award recognizes outstanding athletes who have excelled not only in sports but also in academics, leadership, and sportsmanship.

Aizlyn Albanese '25, Basketball (NYU), has been selected as a 4-time Scholar-Athlete, a 3-time CHSL All-Catholic winner, and a 3-year BCAM Best Award winner. She has been named 1st Team All-State by multiple associations, and has set two historic records: breaking the record for most points scored in a single game and becoming the all-time leading scorer for the Marlins achieving over 1,000 points.

Campbell Flynn '25, Volleyball (University of Nebraska), was awarded Miss Volleyball, Michigan & National Gatorade Player of the Year, and the prestigious 2025 Michigan High School Female Athlete of the Year, presented by the Detroit Athletic Club Foundation. She is a 4-time CHSL All-Catholic selection, a 3-time All-State honoree, and a multi-time All-American. She is also a 2-time Gold Medalist, and has twice been named the Michigan Gatorade Player of the Year.

Kaitlyn Pallozzi '25, Softball (University of Alabama), was named Miss Softball, the 2025 Walt Bazylewicz CHSL Athlete of the Year and Michigan Gatorade Softball Player of the Year. She is a 4-time CHSL All-Catholic, 3-time All-District, 3-time All-Region, and 2-time All-State selection. She has been recognized three times as the top pitcher in the state of Michigan and held the title of #1 ranked pitcher in the entire country.



2025 Nancy Malinowski Athletic Award

This award honors Nancy "Mal" Malinowski, our beloved former athletic director and a trailblazing multi-sport athlete, who dedicated her life to building and supporting Mercy Athletics.

Maeve Casey '25, Ice Hockey (Yale), was a standout in Golf and Lacrosse at Mercy and Ice Hockey outside of school. She achieved five All-Catholic honors, four All-State recognitions, four Scholar-Athlete awards, and played a vital role in helping her teams win three State Championships.



Mackenzie Conway '25, Lacrosse (Brown), was a dominant presence in Swim and Lacrosse all four of her years at Mercy. She captured an incredible six CHSL Championships, earned five All-Catholic selections, was recognized with three All-League honors, achieved First Team All-State recognition four times, and multiple All-American honors at the national level. She was instrumental in helping her team win two MHSAA State Championships, was named a finalist for the CHSL Athlete of the Year and broke the MHSAA all time saves record, surpassing the previous mark of 684 and setting a new standard with 728 career saves.




