- 1. Be a visible presence around the Mercy Athletic Community
- 2. Demonstrate contemporary knowledge of the sport and an ability to cultivate new skills with students through drills, sequenced plays and encouragement on and off the field
- 3. Establish clear expectations and consequences; deliver criticism in a manner that upholds the

dignity of each athlete while maintaining high expectations

- 4. Plan and conduct practice sessions focusing on skill development, strategy and teamwork
- 5. Collaborate with assistant coaches to ensure a consistent approach across the program.
- 6. Establish a positive relationship with coaches, athletes, parents, officials, and community members
- 7. Provide proper safeguards for maintenance and protection of students, equipment and facilities
- 9. Maintains discipline and works to increase morale and cooperation
- 10. Perform additional duties which may be assigned by the Athletic Director
- 11. Coordinate and run summer camps

- A candidate should have previous coaching experience
- Knowledge of Lacrosse rules, tactics and technical aspects
- A commitment to provide students/athletes with a positive sports experience
